

The president greeted the participants and commented that after the forced suspension of the General Assembly to be held in Brittany, we are facing the experience of holding it online for the first time. 3.1 Minutes.

The minutes of the Extraordinary General Assembly (new Statutes and Internal Regulations) held on 1 June 2019 in Aosta were put to the vote. Minutes was approved with 1 vote against and no abstentions. The minutes of the Ordinary General Assembly held on 1 June in Aosta were also put to the vote. They were unanimously approved.

2°.-**Project 1. President.**

2.1 President's Report.

Although everyone was aware of the content of the report as it had been sent in advance and was included in the dossier, Pere Lavega summarised the most important points of his report. These are difficult times for all of us but we have to continue promoting the values of the JDT. Our patrimony is increasing, we are already 74 members with the incorporation this year of 5 entities and the presence, for the first time, of 6 individual members. Our association is growing, and it is doing so by extending its borders and welcoming new members from Eastern Europe and outside the European Union. He commented on the different actions carried out for the external projection of the EYTSGA and the internal one in support of its members, and the participation in different European Projects Erasmus +.

A vote was taken and unanimously approved.

2.2 Amendment of the Rules of Procedure.

Due to a discrepancy between articles 17 and 38 of the Internal Regulations, in the French and English versions, concerning the deadline for the payment of the annual fee, the new wording of these articles was unanimously approved, as follows:

Article 17. Payment of the membership fee

The payment will be made to the AEJeST bank account before April 30th of each year, considering the fee to be paid with the presentation of the bank receipt. Any instalment paid to the AEJeST is definite, without the possibility of being reimbursed.

The administration of the AEJeST bank account is the sole responsibility of the Treasurer, President and Secretary General.

Article 38. Nature

The General Assembly is the supreme governing body of the AEJeST in which all full members of the AEJeST are represented. It is made up of representatives of the associations as well as pledges of individual members. At the GA, each legal entity member has one vote. A system of representation of natural persons members by means of compromiser is established. Each compromiser has one vote.

The other representatives of each legal entity as well as the non-committal individual members and honorary members have the right of access to the General Assembly and can participate in the debates, but do not have the right to vote, except if they are members of the CA.

All legal persons and pledges that are up to date with the payment of all their dues shall have the right to vote.







2.3 Amendment of the Rules of Procedure.

Modification of article 25 in the sense of incorporating a new logo (with the initials AEJeST more visible) to be used indistinctly, depending on the moment and the support, together with the traditional logo (blue flag with the E of Europe and stars), and also its respective negatives.



It was adopted with one vote against and no abstentions.

The secretary reminds and advises that it is advisable for all members to use these logos in their various documents and information media.

The president informs that the CA will present to the General Assembly the modification of the Internal Regulations to include the possibility of holding online Assemblies, because it does not prohibit it, but it does not contemplate it either.

3°.- Project 3. Secretary General.

3.1 Meetings of the Council Boards.

The Secretary informs that since the Aosta General Assembly, the Council Boards has met 9 times: 6 by videoconference, 2 by e-mail and 1 in person, in Berga (Barcelona). The Secretary would like to record his thanks to the Companya de Jocs l'Anònima for the good organisation and the attention they have given.

3.2 Upcoming Assemblies.

General Assembly 2021. 21-24 October in Svetvinčenat, Istria, Croatia. Organised by Istarski Pljočkarski Savez (approved at the AG 2018). Milivoj Pacenti provides brief information which will be expanded and sent to members six months before the meeting.

General Assembly 2022. In September, in Verona, Italy. Requested by the Associazione Giochi Antichi, on the occasion of the 20th edition of the Tocati Festival. Giorgio Paolo Avigo gave brief information. *It was put to the vote and adopted unanimously.*

General Assembly 2023. Dates to be decided, in Pontivy, Brittany, France. Requested by the Confédération FALSAB after this year's suspension due to the health scare. FALSAB had justified its absence and documented its wish to organise this Assembly. *It was put to the vote and approved unanimously.*

3.3 Upcoming CA meetings.

The secretary informs that no request has been registered to organise the 2021 CA meeting. The possibility of organising it by the CA itself at the headquarters in La Almunia de Doña Godina has been assessed.

Paulo Coêlho stated that the Federação Portuguesa do Jogos Tradicionais is considering the possibility of organising it in Lisbon or in the University of Coimbra.

Ricardo Pérez y Verdes stated that both he and his Town Council are very interested in organising a meeting of the CA in the next few years in the Museo Etnóludico de Galicia, in Ponteceso, in the province of La Coruña, Galicia.

3.4 Registration and deregistration of members. Presentation.

The Secretary informed that this Assembly must approve the admission of 11 new members, belonging to three new countries (Serbia, Greece and Cyprus), of which 6 are individual members, a new option following the approval of the Statutes and Internal Regulations at the General Assembly in Aosta 2019. The dossier contains the documentation they have been asked to provide in order to make their activities known. The floor is then given to their representatives to briefly address the AG members:

4°.- Project 9. Social resources.

4.1 Good Practice Awards 2020.

Carmen Fernández informs that following the receipt and evaluation of the nominations for the 2020 Good Practice Awards, this year they have been awarded to:

- Individual Category: Pierino Daudry

- Collective Category: Coordinadora Intercomarcal de Bitlles y Birles

- Member of Honour: Pierre Parlebas

As it is impossible to present the awards physically, which will be done at the next Assembly, they are shown on the screen together with a photo of the winners.

4.2 Amendment of the Regulation.

It is proposed that article 28 of the Internal Regulations be modified so that the final decision on the award winners each year is not the responsibility of the Council Boards but of the General Assembly. The Secretary reminds that the candidates can be presented by the Council Boards or by any member of AEJeST with the support of three entities. The Assembly will be consulted one month before the AG so that they can attend and present the awards there. *Unanimously approved*.

4.3 Future challenges.

Carmen Fernández proposes the need to make an inventory of Games and Sports represented in the AEJeST (collection of regulations, images, audios, videos... provided by the members) through a working commission that will classify, archive and edit the documentation collected to give visibility to both the AEJeST and the members, freely offering this information through the association's website or a YouTube channel. This work requires an annual budget so that the Commission can collect complementary information to that provided by the members.

Afterwards, Pierino Daudry, on his own behalf, and Jordi Torrente, as president, on behalf of the Coordinadora Intercomarcal de Bitlles y Birles, were given the opportunity to address the Assembly; both expressed their gratitude and their will to continue working in the world of the Traditional Games, with more strength after this recognition. As it was not possible for Pierre Parlebas to be present due to technological problems, Pere Lavega did so on his behalf to express his gratitude and to remember that the winner, age of 85 years but very active, is the person who, from the point of view of scientific prestige, gives more value to the traditional games worldwide, as shown by the many awards received, being able to say that he is the Darwin, the Einstein, the Piaget of the Traditional Games.

5°.- Project 4. Economic Resources.

5.1 Statement of accounts for the financial year 2019.

The treasurer is unable to connect at this time and it is the secretary who reports the movements recorded in the financial year 2019, as well as the most significant variations with the budget. After income of 13,914.60 euros and expenditure of 9,321.08 euros, the financial year shows a surplus of 4,592.80 euros, so that the balance in the AEJeST bank account on 31 December 2019 was +23,500.43 euros. No clarifications were requested and a vote was taken. *It was unanimously approved*.

5.2 Budget 2020.

The secretary presented the 2020 budget, very similar to previous years, highlighting in the income section the contribution of the members and the contribution from the European Projects. In the expenses, a face-to-face meeting of the CA is envisaged, but it is possible that it cannot be held due to the health situation, a situation that will also affect the living and travel expenses of the members of the CA. As a novelty, and given that there will be no other important expenses, a merchandising section is included to distribute among the members and make the AEJeST more visible. No clarifications were requested and a vote was taken. *It was unanimously approved.*







6°.- Project 7. Communication resources.

Fabrizio Vierin says that the aim of his project is to promote the meeting and communication between the different disciplines of the same family of games, the different realities, through networking. The aim of the AEJeST is to stimulate these exchanges, to create networks between members, which is not an easy task, so we need associations to act as a driving force, even to create a project that will lead us to look for new members, to carry out interviews, conferences, meetings. It is not a question of creating an association within the AEJeST, but of promoting this network within our network of networks, which is the AEJeST. A good example in this line has been carried out by the Coordinadora Intercomarcal de Bitlles y Birles in its 37 years of activity, a circumstance that has undoubtedly been highlighted a few moments ago with the 2020 Good Practices Award, which is explained by its president, Jordi Torrente.

Jordi Torrente commented on the activity supported by a PowerPoint presentation in the three languages to facilitate the understanding of his message. He says that, coinciding with the feeling of the AEJeST, they started a spontaneous action with the aim of grouping the largest number of bowling games of six, starting from the contacts of the members of the AEJeST and reaching out to others not belonging to our association. The CIB is a small organisation that develops activities in small towns in the province of Tarragona, in Catalonia, with the aim of recovering, promoting and disseminating its game of six pin bowling, the Bitlles. This idea of networking was born in 2014 on the occasion of the organisation of the General Assembly of the AEJeST in l'Hospitalet de l'Infant, bringing together 13 modalities of six pin bowling, achieving three objectives: to visualise six pin bowling, to create a feeling of a family of games and to create a network of relationships. The second experience we had in 2017 on the occasion of the meeting organised in Aranda de Duero by the Asociación La Tanguilla. In 2018 we organised again a meeting in our territory with eight games and more than 200 participants, consolidating the relationship network. This year the fourth meeting was planned, organised in France by Alain Bovo and the Quilles de Six, but it has been postponed to next year. The president Pere Lavega congratulates Jordi Torrente and says that the work done by the Coordinator is a good example of how we can work with internal networks within the AEJeST network.

7º.- Project 8. Technological resources.

7.1 Website.

Biel Pubill reports on the actions taken to update and restructure the website. To this end, a contract was signed with the company 7.11 Creative Studio, which will be in charge of maintenance, domain, updates, backups and incident resolution. The changes are explained and visualised, highlighting the new section of members of the AEJeST, with a very complete file with the data of each association, and a search engine with filters to know the members by countries and groups. He asked for the data to be reviewed and for any possible incidents to be reported. He stated that there are many other ideas that will have to be developed in the future.

7.2 Other actions and future challenges.

Biel Pubill went on to say that the AEJeST is also strengthening its presence on social networks, being present on Facebook, Instagram and Twitter, and in this field he is grateful for the collaboration of Felipe Gonzalo. He appealed to everyone to mention AEJeST and share the information whenever they take action on social networks.

The AEJeST newsletter had been revived and would be published digitally twice a year. And a working committee has been set up, made up of Carmen Fernández, Guy Jaouen, Fabricio Vierin and Milivoj Pacenti, which is preparing a leaflet to give visibility to the Association and its members.

8°.- Project 6. International projects.

Paulo Coêlho informs about the European Projects in which AEJeST or some of its members are participating, and accompanies the explanation with a presentation that everyone has in the dossier, in which the projects, the participating members, the objectives, the budget and the links for further information are listed. He comments on the projects already completed, Geo Ludens, Bridge, and Together, which ends this year. Three projects have been presented in this year's call: Trawecu (sustainable cultural tourism and traditional wrestling), Batball sports' (project bringing together organisations managing ball and bat games) and Opportunity (social inclusion and gender equality in traditional games), in which 8 members of AEJeST participate and which, if chosen, will have a budget of over 400.000 euros.

9°.- Project 2. International relations

9.1 Report by Guy Jaouen.

Guy Jaouen explained the situation of the existing international organisations around the JDTs. This situation is sometimes difficult to decipher as many organisations call themselves the "global organisation of TGS". He reports on the ITSGA Board elections held in March 2020, in which Guy Jaouen was re-elected President, Pere Lavega Vice-President - as President of AEJeST, and Paolo Avigo Board member representing AEJeST.

9.2 Report by Pere Lavega.

Pere Lavega complements the information provided in the President's report at this General Assembly, describing the active participation (in person and online) in different international events with the intention of making AEJeST visible worldwide. It highlights the relations with:

- UNESCO (AEJeST has been reaccredited as NGO advisor to the Intangible Cultural Heritage Committee; participation in events held by UNESCO in Antananarivo, Madagascar (meetings of African Ministers); South Korea (international martial arts meeting; Paris: TGS colloquium, Heritage and Diplomacy; online meeting with UNESCO; support for the candidature of Tocatì as an example of good practice for the promotion of the TGS).

- European Commission: contact with Mr. Yves Le Lostecque to coordinate his participation in the AG; presentation of different European projects.

- CIO, online meetings to discuss possible collaborations.
- World Ethnosport Confederation (WEC), signing of partnership agreement in Antalya (Turkey).
- African Association of TSG (AAJST), participation in international meeting in Tunisia.
- Asia and America: participation in various international conferences (by internet) in India and Guatemala.

10°.- Project 5. Language Resources.

Giorgio Paolo Avigo reports that in these 3 years of work, an attempt has been made to create a translation working group, with knowledge of French and English, as the documents to be translated arrive in Spanish. In addition to Milivoj, the group currently consists of Alain Bovo for French and Marco Avigo, from AGA, for English. Giorgio Paolo Avigo thanked them for their availability and informed everyone of the possibility of joining this not closed group.

The secretary also appreciates the work of the translators and as an example he points out that the Dossier delivered contains 125 pages translated into the three official languages of the AEJeST, which represents a great work in a short period of time.

11°.- Proposals, Requests and Questions.

No proposals had been submitted in advance and no requests or questions were registered. The president appreciates the presence of members from outside AEJeST representing other organisations related to Traditional Games and Sports:

- Irene Morales, researcher from the National University of Mexico, thanks for the invitation and is very happy to have witnessed the work of the AEJeST which will undoubtedly enrich her research work.

- Zhaira Ben Chaâbane, from the Association des sports et jeux traditionnels africains, expressed the same wish that these meetings would encourage intercontinental collaborations.

The meeting was adjourned at thirteen hours and thirty minutes, of which I, as secretary, drew up these minutes and signed them with the approval of the chairman.

President's Report

Four years ago, I had the honor of assuming the responsibility of being president of the AEJeST. 17 people from the board of directors have worked intensely alongside me. Along with them, other members of the AEJeST have also voluntarily participated. Thanks to this cooperative work we have been able to activate a team of teams to constitute an exemplary network of networks.

Now, just before the 2021 general assembly in Croatia, it is a good time to take stock of some of the most relevant aspects of this mandate

Let us remember that our strategic plan focused attention on two main lines of action: a) the improvement of internal cohesion of the members and b) the international projection of our Association.

Internally, I would like to highlight the following actions:

- Updating of the statutes and drafting of internal regulations that have been improved over the years;
- Activation of physical, online and virtual meetings of the board of directors;
- Support for the organizers of general assemblies and winter meetings.
- Incorporation of a legal advisor and commercial development of the AEJeST;
- Regulation of the administrative and legal management of the AEJeST;
- Coordination of administrative secretary actions with the Fuerte;
- Stimulation of members' networking;
- Incorporation of a simultaneous translation system for the official online events of the AEJeST;
- Incorporation of the figure of individual members of the AEJeST;
- Admission of new organizations and individual members;
- Assistance and support to official actions organized by members of the AEJeST (meetings, festivals, seminars, congresses, candidacy for UNESCO as good practice, doctoral theses and publications).
- Activation of recognitions of organizations, people and honorary members that are examples
 of good practices for the safeguarding and promotion of traditional sports and games;
- Activation of various European Erasmus + projects with the active presence of members of the AEJeST;
- Updating of the website and activation of other social networks;
- Regular preparation of AEJeST bulletins;
- Elaboration of a video of the Bolo Vaqueiro as the first example of promotion of the traditional sports and games of the AEJeST, as intangible cultural heritage;
- Contact with all members of the AEJeST to find out your needs in times of Covid-19. As a result of the responses, it was decided to reduce the annual quotas for 2021 to 50%;
- Constitution of an electoral commission to guarantee maximum transparency and democracy in the electoral process for the 2021-2025 term.

In relation to international projection, AEJeST has been very active. I would like to highlight the following actions:

- Organization of two European Forums of traditional games and sports that have made it possible to show the visibility of our members to people and organizations from four continents;
- Re-accreditation of the AEJeST (NGO, 90106) by UNESCO, section Intangible Cultural Heritage (ICH) as an NGO (years 2020-2024).

- Participation in UNESCO working commissions;
- Participation in activities and conferences organized by the European Commission.
- In Europe. Attendance at international activities promoted by international organizations (UNESCO, European Commission, Bulgarian Government ...);
- In Africa. Attendance at activities organized by ITSGA and the African Association of Traditional Sports and Games AAJST; the Association Tunisienne pour la sauvegarde des jeux et sports du patrimoine (ATSJSP) and also by UNESCO (meeting of ministers in Madagascar).
- In Latin America: attendance at international online events organized by (Asociación Panamericana of TSG; Mexican Federation of TSG, and other organizations from Guatemala, Mexico, Chile, Colombia and Brazil)
- in Asia (cooperation in the constitution of the Asian Association of Traditional Sports and Games; cooperation with the Iranian Federation of Traditional Sports and Games; formalization of agreements with the World Ethnosport Confederation; and with the Korean Traditional Culture Center that has enabled the activation of a first project pilot with educational centers in Spain and South Korea).

The examples shown in the two major areas of action confirm that the AEJeST is an active, dynamic and exemplary network in the democratic functioning of a continental organization. I think that the AEJeST is a highly visible, respected and recognized association at European and international level, both by official bodies (European Commission, UNESCO) and by international organizations. Internally, we have been expanding the number of members and countries representing Europe. In addition, we have facilitated the visibility and networking of our members.

For this reason, I would like to thank in a special way the members of the board of directors, the people who have collaborated in their different working teams. I would also like to thank all the members who have organized the general assemblies and the meetings of the board of directors of the AEJeST. Likewise, the people and organizations that have received recognition of AEJeST for being our ambassadors for the safeguarding and promotion of traditional sports and games as cultural heritage deserve an extraordinary mention.

I am looking forward to meeting you in Croatia to celebrate that little by little, after overcoming the pandemic, our network returns to normal, moving towards the consolidation of a network of networks.

REPORT PROJECT 3 (2017-2021)

José Ángel Hoyos Perote and David Abascal Monte

Since the election of the new Council Board at the Extraordinary Assembly of 28 October 2017 in Palma de Mallorca, the activity developed from Project 3, General Secretariat, has been very intense, and very different from the actions carried out in previous years.

Until then, the Council Board met face-to-face once per year. In the last four years, thanks to the possibilities offered by the new online communication platforms and in compliance with the Strategic Plan proposed by this team, the Council Board has met 33 times:

- 6 face-to-face meetings: Palma de Mallorca, 2017; La Almunia de Doña Godina, 2018; Mechelen, 2018; Cangas del Narcea, 2019; Aosta, 2019; and Berga, 2019).
- 20 meetings by videoconference.
- 7 meetings virtually by mail.

It is worth mentioning that in the videoconferences of the last year we have been able to count on simultaneous translation, making the meetings more dynamic and quicker.

Coordinated the organisation of 5 General Assemblies:

- Hofstade-Zems, Belgium, 2018.
- Aosta, Italy, 2019.
- Bretagne, France, 2020 (although in the end it could not take place due to the Covid-19 pandemic).
- On line, 2020
- Svenvinčenat, Croatia, 2021.

In addition to the board and AG meetings, the two members of Project 3 have actively participated in other meetings: website, fold-out information leaflet, Good Practice Awards, Bolo Vaqueiro video, Erasmus+ Opportunity Project, Election Commission...

To highlight the hard work carried out by the CA over nine months to present to the Extraordinary Assembly in Aosta the revision of our Statutes and the drafting of the first Rules of Procedure.

The work carried out in the organisation of the two European Forums of Traditional Games and Sports was also intense, especially the first one, until the INEFC of Lleida offered to use the Zoom platform unconditionally. Special thanks to the teachers of the GIAM group and the INEFC for their collaboration.

Another of the activities carried out has been the elaboration of logos, banners, roll-up, dossier... and to give a uniform format to all the documentation sent to the members.

All members have been promptly informed of all these actions in the three official languages of AEJeST (French, Spanish and English). All incoming and outgoing mails (more than two thousand mails in these four years) have been registered and all attached documents have been filed.

19 associations joined the AEJeST, 7 of them from Eastern European countries, and 9 individual members. On the other hand, 13 associations left, 5 of them voluntarily and the others deactivated due to non-payment of dues.

A relevant event in this mandate was the inauguration of the Museum of the Traditional Game in La Almunia de Doña Godina and the signing of the collaboration agreement with its Town Hall to establish the administrative headquarters of the AEJeST there.

3.1 Proposals. Amendment of Article 51.2 of the Rules of Procedure. Delete: "*The payment of the quotas owed subsequently will give the right to be included in the census*", for discrepancies with the Statutes and other articles of the Rules of Procedure.

Statutes:

Article 6. *"The AEJeST General Assembly is made up of representatives of the member organisations in good standing, the full members of the Council Board, as well as the individual members in good standing"*.

Rules of Procedure:

- Article 17. Payment of the membership fee

"The payment will be made to the AEJeST bank account <u>before April 30th of each year</u>, considering the fee to be paid with the presentation of the bank receipt".

- Article 38. Nature
- *"All legal persons and pledges that are up to date with the payment of all their dues shall have the right to vote".* - Article 51. Electoral system. CA elections

2.- "The CA or the Electoral Commission shall update the census of eligible members and electors composing the General Assembly two months prior to the date on which the elections are to be held. <u>It will be a prerequisite</u> to be included in the census to be current at that time of payment of dues. The payment of the quotas owed subsequently will give the right to be included in the census".

4.- "Any person who is endorsed by the legal entity member to which he belongs may apply for President or CA member of the AEJeST. <u>Participation is expressly excluded for entities that were not up to date with their quotas</u> at the time the elections were called".

PROJECT 9: SOCIAL RESOURCES

ACTIONS CARRIED OUT IN THE MANDATE 2017-2021

Vice-Presidents: Carmina Fernández Amat and Fernando Maestro Guerrero

1.- Collection of strengths, (through questionnaires) centralized action in El Fuerte, administrative headquarters of the AEJeST:

- 2017: Questionnaires were prepared in the three languages to be carried out through telephone contacts with the partners.
- 2018: Questionnaires were completed in person at the General Assembly. And the rest of the questionnaires were sent by email. If the received data was organized simultaneously and archived.
- 2019: The global socio-health situation forced us to slow down the pace of work.
- 2020: The information on the associations of the AEJeST continues to be completed. This year the different modalities practiced in each member association are also accessed through their social networks or their websites.

2.- Audiovisual inventory.

An inventory with an audiovisual format has been started, which aims to recontextualize the traditional games and sports represented in the different Associations, Federations, Sports Schools, etc ... that are members of our European Association. At the same time, the audiovisual material produced will allow to recognize the most representative specialties and also those with less representativeness, which will serve to contribute to their greater visibility.

As a first example to start the documentary collection, a video has been made about the Bolo Vaqueiro, a reflection of the culture and heritage of the Principality of Asturias. For this, it has had the collaboration and sponsorship of the Cangas del Narcea City Council. We have tried to make the video with the highest quality within our reach, so that it serves as a sample of what could be done for each of the members of the Association. The continuity of this project will allow publishing the edited videos on the AEJeST website, to enhance the recognition of the activities between us and also publish them on the YouTube channel, which will allow the free access of the general public to this information.







3.- Annual organization of the Recognitions for Good Practices

PROJCET 2: INTERNATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS

ACTIONS CARRIED OUT IN THE MANDATE 2017-2021 Vice-Presidents: Guy Jaouen and Nicolae Dobre

Since 2017, the project called N° 2 could be called "commission for international relationships", that is to say relations with national organizations outside AEJeST, not only at European level but also outside with some ITSGA member organizations.

It is also the relations with intergovernmental organizations such as UNESCO and all the structures of the civil society which revolve around it, but also with other international TSG organizations. President of AEJeST is therefore often called upon to intervene directly as a legal representative.

In 2018, the committee asked for their collaboration to highly qualified officials and experts, including the president of AEJeST, and a group of 13 people was created. The group then had to break up with the Russian Kylasov of the Ethnosport World Society for practices that we considered being unfair and unethical.

Starting with global relationships, we can say that the restart in 2017 of the process of forming an International TSG Advisory Committee by UNESCO (ICTSG) had raised a lot of hope, with also a lot of travel and work. We have to precise that UNESCO had wished to place, in a fairly undemocratic manner, the Pakistani Khalil Ahmed Khan at the head of the Ad-Hoc committee in charge of preparing this creation. However in 2019, after several meetings, Mr Khan freed himself from UNESCO's authority and unilaterally dissolved the Ad-Hoc committee to create his own organization, the ICTSG. Since 2019, this organization, whose name in English is intentionally identical to the one planned by UNESCO, create confusion and has been acting on behalf of UNESCO and its member countries. All UNESCO collaborators, including many members of the AEJeST, therefore found themselves in a situation of powerless observers because the officials in charge of this task at UNESCO did not react to this usurpation of identity. However, UNESCO remains a very important support for our actions through the symbolism and the international conventions represented (ICH, etc.).

Another international organization, the WEC (Word Ethnosport Confederation), was created in 2015 in Kyrgyzstan, around the "World Nomad Games", without ever being registered. It was transferred to Turkey in 2018. The backbone of this organization is the Diaspora of Turkish-speaking countries stretching from the Mediterranean to the Chinese border. It has the support of

the Turkish government. The AEJeST signed a partnership agreement with the WEC in 2020, hoping to establish constructive partnerships.

The TAFISA organization is still there even if it is an almost empty box concerning TSG activities. In 2018, it linked up with Russian Kylasov's EWS by means of a convention that said "This memorandum confirms mutual recognition of their world leadership in traditional sports and games." Khalil Khan's ICTSG is also self-centered and says, "The ICTSG owns all rights in and in relation to TSG. Festivals are the exclusive property of the ICTSG which holds all the rights and data relating thereto, etc...". No comment...

AEJeST (and ITSGA) are therefore, in spite of themselves, at the heart of a battle between all these organizations which all say or wish to lead the TSG movement at the world level.

It should also be noted that the AEJeST has organized several support actions for the continental organizations that are members of ITSGA, the organization of central and south America (APJDAT), the African organization (AAJST), and that one of Asia (ATSGA).

Now let's talk about the European national level outside the AEJeST. For many years the AEJeST has maintained several informal networks:

1) with the member federations of the FILC (which is a founding member of the AEJeST)

2) with the groups and federations that participated in the TRADWOC project in 2017-2018 (led by AGA Verona). About 30 groups. TRAWECU project (2021-2022) in progress.

3) With groups that work to transmit the games of "bat & sticks" or "bat & balls". (Project Erasmus with the federation Oina)

Networking with these groups has made it possible to create or consolidate many regional networks but also to attract new members for AEJeST. In addition, these networks create the necessary dynamism for the organization of European Erasmus projects.

PROJET 9: LINGUISTIC FRESOURCES

ACTIONS CARRIED OUT IN THE MANDATE 2017-2021

Vice-présidents: Giorgio Paolo Avigo and Milivoj Pacenti

Over the last four years, the group formed around the project has made it possible to translate into French and English the documentation sent to us by the secretariat in Spanish.

The group was made up of people who knew not only the language but also the theme of traditional games and sports as a heritage to be safeguarded, so that the translated texts would be as correct as possible and in line with the ideas and practices of our association.

For this reason, the group is mainly made up of members of AEJeST or people very close to the organisation. The coordinators are Giorgio Paolo Avigo and Milivoj Pacenti, who are currently counting on the collaboration of Alain Bovó for the French translations and Marco Avigo and Dubravka Kodela Pacenti for the English translations.

Biel Pubill has given his availability for the Spanish translations and we will ask for the collaboration, which we hope will be accepted, of Kazimierz Waluch, Bartosz Prabucki and Lea Lozančić to facilitate the translations from and into French and English.

We also aim to bring the vision of AEJEST to as many organisations and people as possible, so we invite the heads of the member organisations to make themselves available to disseminate the information in their national and local language to their networks.





PROYECTO 6: PROYECTOS INTERNACIONALES

Tras la toma de posesión de la Junta Directiva de la AEJeST en 2017, y la consiguiente estructuración de las actividades previstas en Proyectos específicos, entre ellos el Proyecto 6 - Proyectos Internacionales-, identificamos un conjunto de iniciativas de miembros asociados, en el marco del Programa Erasmus.

En el lapso de tiempo comprendido entre parte de 2017 y parte de 2021, identificamos un total de seis (6) Proyectos Europeos en los que la AEJeST y algunos de sus miembros asociados participaron. PROJECT 7: COMMUNICATION RESOURCES

ACTIONS CARRIED OUT IN THE MANDATE 2017-2021

Vice-President: Fabrizio Vierin and Guido Theodule

The coordinators of this project, Fabrizio Vierin and Guido Theodule shared both the programs and the decisions of the AEJEsT board of directors throughout the last four-year period, participating in all the assemblies and meetings in the presence and almost all of those held online during pandemic.

As regards the communications sector at European level, we contributed to the creation of the information leaflet of our association while at the local level (Valle d'Aosta - Italy) we supported the creation of the youtube channels "Télécombat - Rebatta Republic and Radio Bicca" with the intent to give visibility to the Rebatta and Fiolet games.

We took care of the organization of the last AEJEsT assembly before the covid, held in Aosta from 30 May to 2 June 2019 with enthusiasm and pride. The event once again demonstrated how important it is to meet and discuss in person even today that the media and the web play such a big role in society.

The meetings between Palet and Pliocke players continue with the aim of creating in the future a channel of communication and exchange of experiences with other similar games from other nations.

In this regard, the past four years has seen the Italian Federation of Traditional Games and Sports collaborate in the foundation of the WSA - World Slingshot Association, born in November 2019 in China after the agreements signed the year before in Gualdo Tadino (ITA) during the first world championship in slingshot throwing.

A similar collaboration began with the IBA-International Bowlplaying Association which welcomed into its ranks the throwers of the "street ball" and with the ITSF - International Table Soccer Federation after the discipline was integrated into the statute of Figest.

This project has also been in contact with the different initiatives to promote the networking of various families of traditional games and sports of the AEJeST: Skittles, Palet, Wrestling.





PROJECT 8: TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES

ACTIONS CARRIED OUT IN THE MANDATE 2017-2021

Vice-President: Biel Pubill and Alain Bovo

Since the 2017 elections in Palma de Mallorca, I have had the honor of working, together with Alain Bovo, on Project 8. I believe that the work carried out during these four years has been positive. Initially, we set ourselves three objectives:

- Update the WEB (http://jugaje.com): organize it properly, modernize it and make it more attractive
- Edit and send the AEJeST newsletter twice a year
- Promote AEJeST through social networks, basically facebook and instagram.

We believe that the first two objectives have been achieved and consolidated and that we must continue in this line, keeping the WEB updated and, as far as possible, expanding and providing content with some specific areas (projects, assemblies, agreements, publications).

Regarding the third objective, we believe that we are on the right track, since we have increased our presence on these social networks, but we are aware that there is still a long way to go for the AEJeST to be highly visible on social networks.

In addition to these actions, we highlight the preparation and editing of the AEJeST triptych. Its edition involved a shared work with many of the members of the Board of Directors, which has resulted in excellent and attractive material for dissemination and promotion of the AEJeST.







Editorial

Dear family of the ETSGA,

It seems that little by little we are recovering normality in this time of pandemic. After going through difficult times and with a view to closing a new stage in the last years of the ETSGA, we send you this document. Now it has been four years since we started publishing the ETSGA newsletters in this format. Since then the ETSGA has worked intensively from new projects in its strategic plan aimed at improving internal cohesion of the members and the international projection of our Association.

Internally, I would like to highlight the following actions: updating the statutes and drafting internal regulations; activation of physical, online and virtual meetings for members and the board of directors; incorporation of a legal advisor; regulation of the administrative and legal management of the ETSGA; stimulation of members' networking; incorporation of the figure of individual members; admission of new organizations and individual members; activation of recognitions of members and people who are examples of good practices for the safeguarding and promotion of traditional sports and games; activation of various European Erasmus+ projects with the active presence of members of the AEJeST; updating the website and activating other social networks; elaboration of a video of the Bolo Vaqueiro as the first example of promotion of the TSG of the ETSGA. Incorporation of a simultaneous translation system for official events of the ETSGA. All members were also contacted to find out their needs in times of Covid-19. As a result of the responses, it was decided to reduce the annual quotas for 2021 to 50%.

In relation to international projection, ETSGA has been very active. I would like to highlight the following actions: preparation of 2 international Forums that have made it possible to show the visibility of our members to people and organizations from four continents; re-accreditation of ETSGA as an NGO recognized by UNESCO; Representation of the ETSGA in the management team of ITSGA; participation in UNESCO working commissions; participation in activities and congresses organized by the European Commission. Attendance at international activities promoted by international organizations in Europe (UNESCO, European Commission, Bulgarian Government...); in Africa (ITSGA and TSG African Association); in Latin America (Pan American Association of TASG; Mexican Federation of TSG ...); in Asia (cooperation in the constitution of the Asian Association of Traditional Sports and Games; formalization of agreements with the World Ethnosport Confederation; Korean Traditional Culture Center).

For all this, I wanted to thank all the members of the AEJeST and also the board of directors for having allowed our European Association to have been a model association in the way of functioning democratically, in the great challenge of being a network of networks, a team of teams in favour of the safeguarding and promotion of the TSG as intangible cultural heritage.

ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME (2021-2027)

The month of April we experienced a historic event since for the first time the ETSGA was the only European organization invited by the European Commission (Directorate General for Education, Youth, Sport and Culture) that has participated as a speaker in the second European online seminar. SUPPORT FOR THE CREATION OF THE ASIAN SPORTS AND GAMES ASSOCIATION TRADITIONAL (ATSGA






The small federation Salzburg Rangglerverband and TAURISKA company have published the book "Hundstoa Ranggeln. Myth. Culture. Tradition."
